Cases tests will be conducted within 5 business days of receipt and any remaining cases that are unused will be held for an additional 5 business days past the date of report, pending any additional requests from the distributor or end user. If this form is not included with the boxes a "good faith" effort will be made to determine the IPG Rep the 5 day turn around time will start when all information is received.

It is recommended to send 1 bundle of cases in for testing, 2 is preferred. On the following machines 2 bundles are required: UA, CE-10, CE-12.

It is recommended, but not necessary, to also include enough product for at least full case. This will allow for accurate testing as fully packed cases can behave differently from empty ones.
